Thank you again for your time last Thursday to discuss the current consultation on plain/standardised packaging of tobacco products. We appreciated the time to discuss the various considerations from a trade, legal and illicit trade perspective.

As discussed, please find attached the documentation we promised to send you:

* Bird & Bird Paper - I have attached the Executive summary of the paper. I will send you a second email shortly with the long version of the paper (unfortunately the size of the attachments are large and hence needed 2 emails)

* Transcrime Report - This Report assesses the likelihood of increased crime that plain packaging would stimulate here in the UK. It follows a report on the Tobacco Products Directive which Transcrime published earlier in the year.
